I finally got the U.M.W.I. alumni mag. - fall edition. Say did Mrs. Dodd get her Xmas Card? I don't imagine this will be much of an Xmas for Mr. + Mrs. Hepp, not knowing about Jimmy.

The same old routine around here is about to get me down. We do the same thing every day - except we stand neckle row and do exercises.

Barb and myself have moved to another room - there are two of us in it and it is very nice. We have a fire place in one end and drawers to keep our clothes in - howandowbi. (I've been with ever since Walter Reed) is in here - also a couple of other who
